Summary:

The Network Administrator is responsible for the effective provisioning, installation/configuration, operation, and maintenance of the company's communications and networking environment. This position requires excellent technical, customer service, and organizational skills to support network operations for customer connections, administrative personnel, and staff. It also requires the ability to function successfully in both team and independent work environments.

Position Duties & Responsibilities:

1. Configure and maintain Company's internal computer network.
2. Consult and coordinate network design based on company needs; analyzes workflow, access, information, and security requirements; designs router administration, including interface configuration and routing protocols.
3. Manage network security tools, e.g., firewall, anti-virus, and intrusion detection systems.
4. Identify, troubleshoot, solve, and document network connectivity and performance issues.
5. Monitor network performance and optimize the network for optimal speed and availability.
6. Install, configure and maintain network hardware, e.g., Cisco routers and switches.
7. Deploy, configure and upgrade network software, such as enterprise antivirus or diagnostics programs.
8. Maintains network performance by performing network monitoring and analysis and performance tuning; troubleshoots network problems; escalates problems to partnered vendors as necessary.
9. Secures network by developing access, monitoring, control, and evaluation; maintains documentation and topology maps.
10. Plays a role in cybersecurity by monitoring and protecting VPN gateways and firewalls using intrusion detection and prevention systems.
11. Responsible for maintenance and upgrades of company-wide phone and alternative communication systems such as CMR and Jabber.
12. Coordinates with internet service providers to monitor and maintain WAN connections.

13. Coordinates remote jobsite internet access for Company's project sites.
14. Monitors computer networks and systems to identify how performance can be improved.
15. Responds to IT service requests and incidents.
16. Accomplishes organization goals by accepting ownership for accomplishing new and different requests; exploring opportunities to add value to job accomplishments.
17. Protects organization's value by keeping information confidential.
18. Other duties as assigned.
